Explanation of Responses:

- The Reporting Person received Restricted Stock Units ("RSUs") which represent a contingent right to receive one share of Class A Common Stock for each RSU. This reported transaction represents the settlement of RSUs vested as of October 15, 2022.
- Represents the number of shares withheld by the Issuer to satisfy the tax withholding obligation in connection with the settlement of RSUs.
- This reported transaction represents the settlement of RSUs vested as of October 15, 2022.
- Each RSU represents a contingent right to receive one share of Issuer's Class A Common Stock. Subject to the Reporting Person's continued service, 20% of the RSUs vested on May 1, 2019, and an additional 1/60th of the remaining RSUs vest monthly thereafter for a period of 5 years.
- Each RSU represents a contingent right to receive one share of Issuer's Class A Common Stock. Subject to the Reporting Person's continued service, 25% of the RSUs vested on January 1, 2020, and 1/36th of the RSUs vest monthly thereafter for a period of 3 years.
- Each RSU represents a contingent right to receive one share of Issuer's Class A Common Stock. Subject to the Reporting Person's continued service, 1/48th of the vest monthly for a period of 4 years beginning on May 1, 2019.
- Each RSU represents a contingent right to receive one share of Issuer's Class A Common Stock. Subject to the Reporting Person's continued service, 1/48th of the RSUs vest monthly for a period of 4 years beginning on September 1, 2019.
- Each RSU represents a contingent right to receive one share of Issuer's Class A Common Stock. Subject to the Reporting Person's continued service, 1/48th of the RSUs vest monthly for a period of 4 years beginning on October 1, 2020.
